



COACH TONY DUNGY VISITS GWINNETT, GEORGIA YOUTH DETENTION CENTER

Super Bowl-winning coach and NFL legend Tony Dungy visited the Gwinnett County, Georgia Youth Detention Center on April 9, 2014 in support of the children housed there and to promote his partnership with the One Heart mentoring project.

Coach Dungy explained that en route to his Indianapolis Colts winning the Super Bowl, they were tied or behind their arch-rival New England Patriots for 59 minutes of the AFC Championship Game. Coming back from a 21-3 halftime deficit, the Colts pulled ahead with one minute to go and won the game.

Dungy encouraged the youth by explaining it was not too late to turn their lives around. They were in the first half of life and the decisions they'd make when leaving Gwinnett could lead to a victory in the end.
